

Hometown hotel makes way for 'glamorous' future

The Groves of Varsity and Manor Village on site of Inn on Crowchild

lenty of stories were told and retold at the Inn on Crowchild in

the past four decades. Back in 1973, it was called Crowchild Inn. It was a popular spot - a place where business deals were been done and undone, relationships started and ended, and friends got together for a cold one. But now, the hometown hotel on Crowchild Trail at 53rd Street N.W. is waiting for the wrecking ball.

After the venerable hotel has been levelled, work will begin on an impressive community of apartment condos by the Statesman Group of Companies.

It will provide housing for both seniors and young professional people in five mid-rise buildings, along with a four-storey professional building.

Demolition of the Inn on Crowchild will begin in October, after which Statesman will undertake a four-year construction schedule to bring the development to fruition.

The Groves of Varsity will be the market condominium element of the project, with 119 one- and two-bedroom units in the first 12-storey building. Subsequent phases will include a second 12-storey tower, along with an eight-floor building.

Across the central courtyard - and also part of the initial phase of housing will be the 144-unit Manor Village at the Groves of Varsity.

It's the latest in a chain of Manor developments undertaken by Statesman in the city. The four-floor professional building will have a walk-in clinic and drugstore on the ground floor, and two floors of medical and other services. The top floor will have live/work condo.

"We've worked closely with the community on the design of the development and traffic issues," says Garth Mann, president and founder of Statesman. "People in the community are looking forward to what we have to offer them."

But before construction of the residential portions begins, heavy equipment will begin gouging out dirt for a two-hectare, one-level underground parkade that will service all residents. "We'll spend about six months to finish the parkade," says Mann. "Then we'll have about an 18-month construction cycle to finish the first phase — and we should have all construction complete four years from the spring of 201."

Suites in the Groves of Varsity will include one-bedroom with den, two bedrooms, and two bedrooms with den.

They will measure from 700 to slightly more than 1,600 square feet. Prices will run from 300,000. Units in the Manor Village will have one or two bedrooms, with prices starting about \$300,000.

"This is going to be a glam-



orous community and should be well-received," says Mann. "We have already had a high acceptance by Varsity area resi-dents."

But there will be more to the development than just good

development than just good looks.

Manor Village residents have a choice of three types of lifestyle programs — from independent living to respite care for those who might need extra assistance.

They can also take advantage of flexible meal programs, housekeeping services, wellness programs, an in-house physician and limousine service.

For those living in the Groves portion of the development, there will be a rooftop health club — and they can even take advantage of meal programs being offered at the Manor Vil-



lage. "We've tried to think of everything we can to make life

easier for all of our residents," says Mann.
